PRESENTATION

This international WAIMH congress, in partnership with Conecta Perinatal, will be held online on February 16, 17 and 18, 2023.

It will consist of twelve symposia as well as numerous keynote presentations by leading international specialists in the field of perinatal, child and family mental health. Seven symposia will be held in Spanish and five symposia in English, French, German, Italian, Portuguese and Spanish.

This congress is organized by ASMI WAIMH-Spain (<http://asmi.es>), the World WAIMH (<https://waimh.org>) in alliance with the Spanish-speaking Alliance for Perinatal and Family Mental Health "Conecta Perinatal" (<https://conectaperinatal.com>) and with the close collaboration of the the l'Association Européenne de Psychopathologie de l'Enfant et de l'Adolescent (<https://www.aepea.org>) together with other European affiliates of the WAIMH.

The objective of this congress on "Perinatal, childhood and family: how do we care?" is to promote quality care for the mental health of mothers, fathers and their babies from preconception onwards. The congress aims to facilitate meetings, scientific communication, interdisciplinary exchanges and the development of regional, national and international solidarity alliances between public and private social and health services and public or private entities defending the rights of families.

This congress will bring together institutions, organizations and professionals working on projects related to outpatient and inpatient father-mother-baby joint care facilities; maternity centers linked to local psyperinatal networks; associations of users and affected families; interdisciplinary services for perinatal mental health care; coordinated socio-health networks for the prevention and follow-up of perinatal psychopathology; mother-father-baby therapeutic outpatient centers; parenting care centers; mother-child centers; baby care centers; perinatal psychopathology prevention and care units; home care social-health teams; perinatal mental health prevention and care social teams; mobile outpatient home care teams for families far from urban centers; teams of midwives, gynecologists and pediatricians; 0-3 educators sensitized in the detection of signs of suffering in babies and families in coordination with early care centers; antenatal education and prevention programs; early detection programs for the risk of perinatal pre- and postnatal psychopathology; programs for the early detection of developmental risk in babies; scales and procedures for early detection and evaluation and detection of developmental risk in babies; programs and models of intervention in situations of risk and manifestation of psychopathology in infants; social and educational programs of awareness and prevention of perinatal psychopathology; social, anthropological and ethnographic research related to perinatal, childhood and family; action-research in perinatal and family psychopathology; other programs and institutions.

GENERAL RULES FOR THE PRESENTATION OF PAPERS OF PAPERS FOR THE CONGRESS



KEYNOTE SPEECHES AND SYMPOSIA

- 1 Only unpublished works that have not been published will be accepted.

Full papers (not only the abstract) should be submitted for evaluation and subsequent publication (papers and posters).
- 2 The maximum number of signatories per work is limited to 6, including the main author and/or presenter. Indicate the name and email of the author who is going to present the work.
- 3 To present a paper at least one of the authors must be registered in the Congress.
- 4 Each registered author may submit a maximum of 2 proposals. His or her name may not appear on more than two.
- 5 As many certificates will be issued for each paper as there are registered authors.
- 6 The names of all authors should appear on each certificate. The name of the author and co-authors should appear with both surnames preceded by the first name. The order in which the authors appear will be used for the subsequent edition of the certificates to be handed out at the congress, as well as in the publications.
- 7 The sending of the works will be made in the following mail: organizacioncongreso@asmi.es

- 8 The authors of the central papers, symposium papers and free communications, unless expressly communicated otherwise, give permission to CONECTA PERINATAL and ASMI WAIMH-Spain to publish them on the website of both entities and in the book of the conference, expressly waiving the economic rights of authors, with full preservation of their intellectual rights in paper and digital format.
 - Papers should be no longer than 3000 words, free papers no longer than 1500 words, and should be sent before October 30, 2022 to organizacioncongreso@asmi.es.
 - It is recommended to follow the APA (American Psychological Association)/Vancouver guidelines, in their latest editions.



POSTERS

POSTER SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

- The posters must be sent in PDF format in its final version to be evaluated through WeTransfer.
- Once accepted, they must submit a video file in MP4 format, with a maximum duration of 5 minutes.
- It is recommended to follow the APA (American Psychological Association)/Vancouver guidelines, in their latest editions.
- Priority will be given to posters with the following structure:
 - a. Introduction
 - b. Objectives and/or Hypotheses
 - c. Justification
 - d. Method (type of design; sample; instruments)
 - e. Results
 - f. Discussion and/or Conclusions
- Dimensions: 0.90 m wide x 1.20 m high (vertical format). DIN A0.
- The best poster presented at the congress will be recognized with a special mention.
- Design: free



FREE COMMUNICATIONS

RULES FOR THE PRESENTATION OF FREE PAPERS

- The author will send a video file in MP4 format, with a maximum duration of 10 minutes, in which he/she will present his/her work. It will be sent through We Transfer.
 - You can make the presentation supported by a Power Point presentation so that the presentation can be seen in the video and the speaker's voice can be heard simultaneously.
 - In the case of not using visual support, the video will show the speaker.
 - Those registered for the congress will have an e-mail address to send queries to the authors. It will be necessary to provide an address for this purpose.
 - The text of the oral communication, with a maximum length of 1500 words, could be published in the journal NACIENDO, provided that it complies with the rules of publication, made available for communication proposals.
- In order to do so, authors must send the complete paper (and adapted to these rules) to organizacioncongreso@asmi.es
- The deadline for the submission of the text is October 30, 2022.
 - Unless expressly communicated otherwise, the author/s give permission to CONECTA PERINATAL and ASMI WAIMH-Spain for the work to be published on the website of both entities and in the book of the conference, with express waiver of the author's economic rights and with full preservation of intellectual rights, in paper and digital format.
 - The communication will be broadcasted on a deferred basis through the congress platform, and the author will be informed of the broadcasting date decided by the organization.

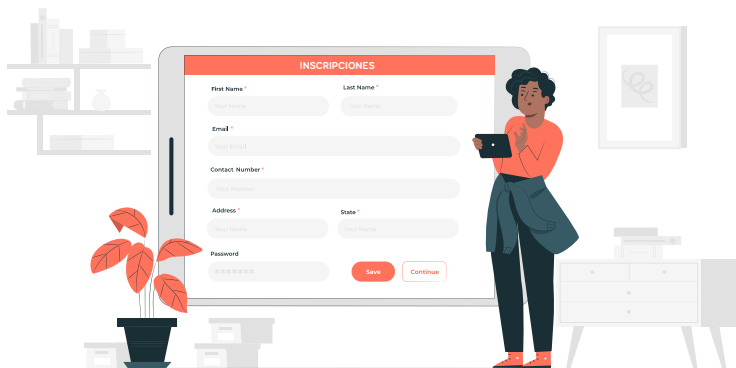

Through regional and world congresses and publications, including the Journal of Infant Mental Health, it disseminates scientific, educational and clinical work for young children and their caregivers.

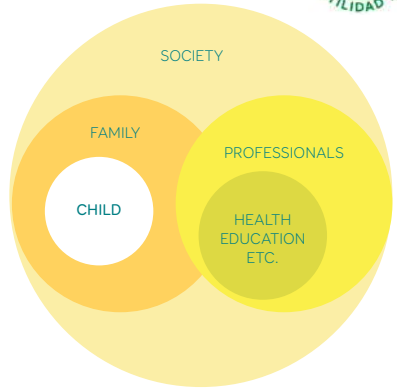
ASMI Objectives

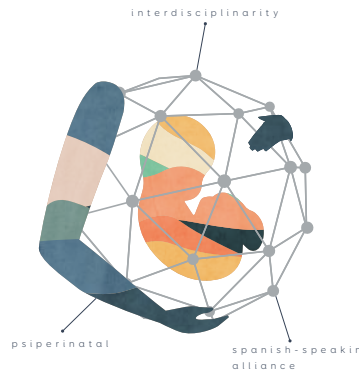

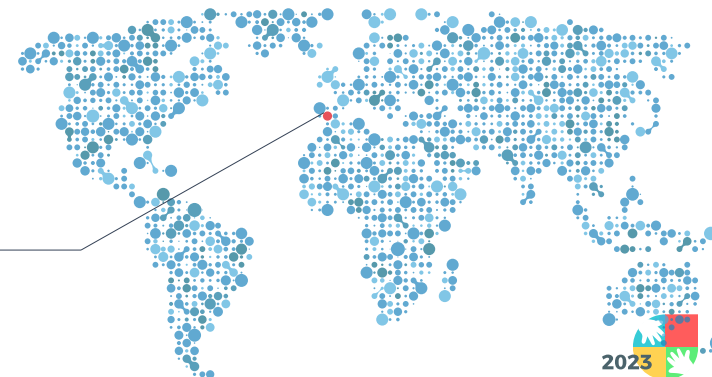
