



The creation of the Spanish-speaking Alliance for Perinatal and Family Mental Health CONECTA PERINATAL was fostered by ASMI / WAIMH Spain in June 2020, with Pascual Palau Subiela responsible for the initiative and its coordination. It takes part in the dynamics of the Global Alliance for Maternal Mental Health (<https://globalalliancematernalmentalhealth.org/>) to which it has belonged as a member since August 2020, and in close collaboration with the Francophone Alliance for Perinatal Mental Health (<https://alliance-psyperinat.org/>), the Maternal Mental Health Alliance (<https://maternalmentalhealthalliance.org/>) and the Canadian Alliance.

This network aims to integrate scientific and social institutions from Spain and other Spanish-speaking countries, as well as European and international institutions willing to support it in the effort to achieve excellent, coordinated health and social care, looking after the perinatal mental health of mothers, fathers and babies.

CONECTA PERINATAL aims to bring together the largest possible number of Spanish-speaking national and international groups of users, scientific bodies and non-profit public and private associations, federations and confederations, in order to continuously foster true prioritisation of public policies related to the perinatal period and in particular its psychic aspects.

It is not intended to be just another scientific society, nor an association, nor a federation. Rather, it aims to facilitate connections and alliances between institutions and users, since future babies and parents deserve solid information about the psiperinatal resources available in their region and about their national and international rights to help take care of their important maternal and paternal role as of the time of periconception, through pregnancy and post-partum, and into their children's early years.

CONECTA PERINATAL aims to promote the development of adapted, sustained care for families, strengthening awareness and ties among all professionals giving care in that period, by facilitating interdisciplinary, inter-institutional ties.

The work in the coalition of organisations and specialists to improve perinatal mental health care for all the women, their partners and families in Spain and Latin America enables them to speak with a single voice in solidarity and to campaign in favour of women who are experiencing perinatal mental illness or emotional distress, so that they can get the care that they and their families need, where and when they need it.

Thus, working collectively to maximise all of our combined resources through a connected network that helps maintain communication and forge an alliance, we are able to take advantage of our organisational, personal and professional experience, energy and passion to bring about change to benefit women, men and families.

This also helps increase international knowledge, awareness and action in favour of maternal mental health and its fundamental role in children's development, while raising awareness about the high human and economic costs of a lack of specialised perinatal mental health care when necessary, while putting forward evidence-based solutions.

We intend to advocate for all Spanish-speaking countries to develop nationwide policies on maternal mental health, invest in evidence-based services and programmes, as well as to do research into the causes, prevention, impact and treatment of perinatal mental illness, ensuring that the voice of women is central, since it is they who have suffered from maternal mental health problems.
